

West Yorkshire Workforce Development Budget

Core Modules for 2022-23

WD (Workforce Development) is invested in creating transformative change in the workforce. In West Yorkshire, a comprehensive learning needs analysis was undertaken which has been considered in the light of the overall workforce transformation priorities as described in the West Yorkshire People Plan.

Who can access WD training - fair access

The health and care system in West Yorkshire aims to ensure access across professions, geographies and health and care to build a fully integrated workforce. The WD funding is available to support the non-registered and registered workforce and some modules are available as accredited and unaccredited (indicated).

Universities identify entry requirements on their course descriptions and if unclear, please contact the University.

Targeted (ringfenced) provision

Some modules have specific numbers and employing organisations identified (ringfenced) and this is in response to the workforce transformation priorities and ensuring targeted and fair access to learning.

Where modules are provided by HEI's from outside West Yorkshire these are for specific workforce requirements and agreement may be sought via the clinical network lead/programme lead.

Funding for modules – when WD funding might apply

Education and training can potentially be funded from several funding streams of which Workforce Development in West Yorkshire, is only one. The list of funded modules includes those that may be accessed by West Yorkshire staff via other funding streams and where other funding is available this should be applied for before workforce development support.

The other funds that may be available to support training include but are not limited to:

- Apprenticeships – please consider if an apprenticeship may be an appropriate route. Apprenticeships are available in Advanced Practice, Leadership and Management and Education.
- Continuing professional development (CPD) - held by organisations. CPD is individual funding allocation for nurses, AHP's and midwives working within the NHS and General Practice continues for the 22/23 financial year.

A combination of CPD and WD is possible to fund modules for 22/23.
